



A PEACEFUL WALK OF THANKS AND COMMITMENT

Join the West County Climate Circle on Friday, October 17, from 4-5:30 pm for Count The Cost II: A Peaceful Walk of Thanks and Commitment. Participants will start the walk outside the Shelburne Falls Post Office. The route will be about 1.5 miles, ending at the Shelburne Falls Farmers' Market at the corner of Main and Water streets.

In August, about 30 people joined the West County Climate Circle on a peaceful walk through the Village of Shelburne Falls, during which we shared our gratitude for some of the services, organizations, and places of natural beauty that are integral to the health and beauty of our community. This walk gave both participants and observers space to reflect upon and voice concerns about recent executive orders, court decisions, and congressional legislation that have weakened (or soon will weaken) these vital organizations and services. The walk also gave people an opportunity to think about how we feel called upon to support our community as we face these challenges together.
