Did you ever hear the word Midrash? Or its friendly abbreviation, a rash? It is the Hebrew word for a sermon. Rabbis speak about having to go work on their rash for the weekend. Christian clergy have been adopting this language for lay led commentaries on scriptures. Sermons are our word for what the "preacher" does. But we often have lay readers who read the lessons. Many are now including the midrash or rash at the moment of the reading in a five minute addition, which might be called "What this scripture means to me." Bridge pastors often love adding this feature to the Sunday morning worship because it is a tidy and efficient way to find out what congregants think about scripture. We are with you for such a short time. The getting to know you is very important. The more we know about how the faith sounds and reads to you, the better our sermons will be.

The West County Community Meals Program at Trinity Church continues to serve a delicious and nutritious meal every Friday Night at 5:30.

We also have continued to provide three options for enjoying the meal; dine in, take out and drive through.

Over the past year we have been serving approximately 35-50 people per week. After a two year absence due to Covid, students from the Academy at Charlemont have returned to offer their help. A group of 4-6 students and staff have been coming 2-3 times per month. They are great to have around. Shelburne Congregational Church continues to prepare and serve a great meal one Friday each month.

We are always looking for groups to sponsor a meal. You and your friends or coworkers could plan and cook a meal together. It's great fun and a terrific team building activity. We would love to have more involvement from Trinity members. Just pick a Friday night over the next few months and contact us. It only takes 3 or 4 people to do the job and requires only 2-3 hours of your time. The meals program will cover any cost and offer any support needed.
