From the Pastor

Dear friends,

This last Monday night, the 26th of February, the Interfaith Council of Franklin County hosted a panel called "We're all in this Together; a multi generational package of Hope." The panel included a 5th grader from Buckland Shelburne Elementary School, a twenty something Land conservationist, a young climate therapist and a woman who responds to climate change through music. The question posed to all of the panelists was "how do you use your gifts to address the climate emergency?

The responses were diverse; the therapist informed us dealing with trauma, especially for young folk, facing questions about what the world would be like in 20 or 30 years; the conservationist shared about saving a precious wildlife corridor that was going to be developed; the 5th grader talked about a campaign she ran with a few friends to get rid of plastic utensils at the school (and they succeeded) and the naturalist/singer told us about a year long journey she took visiting, for an hour, one place in nature every day for a year and she sang a song she wrote to honor that time.

Because the heat was out in the church where we met, we were crowded into a small meeting space with a few space heaters; it was crowded and extended out into the cold hallway. But we were warmed by our own enthusiasm. The questions we were left with were: how do you find joy even in the midst of worry about the future; and how do you use your gifts to address the climate situation?

Lois Bascom, with the support of many others in the church, is heading up our efforts to learn more and act more around climate change at our church. We have the "One Home, One Future" banner on the front of the parsonage and will receive materials from that campaign for Earth Day Sunday, April 21. We have also slowly been getting rid of plastic use here at the church. If you want to use your gifts for this work at the church, contact Lois.


COMMUNION GLASSES
